Addendum # 03 RFQ 2024-17 Questions and Answers II

- Q1. Under the Anticipated A/E Scope of Professional Services, Geotechnical Engineering and Independent Cost Estimating are not listed, but they were discussed at the site walk-through meeting. Are these subconsultant services required to be included in the A/E scope and fee quote?
 - **A.** On our capital projects we typically contract for Geotechnical and cost estimating directly and not through the architect.
- Q2. Regarding the Phase 2 Design Services task "Implement design requirements for the State of Oregon 1% for Art Program", will SOU be managing the solicitation, selection, and administration of artists' proposals, or is the A/E consultant solely responsible for this requirement? (On past campus projects with 1% for Art involving our firm, SOU has led and/or managed this process.)
 - A. The Oregon Arts Commission manages the art solicitation and selection process. A representative of the architectural firm typically participates as a member of the selection committee. Contracts with the selected artist(s) are between the Oregon Arts Commission and SOU and do not involve the architect.
- Q3. Does the University require the Architect to provide Construction Cost Estimation at Schematic Design and Construction Documents Phases as part of the Services?
 - A. No. cost estimating is not included in this RFP
- Q4. Does the University require the Architect to provide the Geotechnical Report?
 - A. See Q1.
