
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS #2024-08
PARKING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM
RESPONSE TO CLARIFYING QUESTIONS I
November 25, 2024

Note that these are questions submitted by interested firms to this solicitation. The below answers are for clarification purposes only and in no way alter or amend the solicitation as published.

1. **QUESTION:** Where can proposers find the university's current vehicle regulations and parking information?

ANSWER: Please see the following website for Oregon Tech's 2024-2025 Vehicle Regulations & Parking Information issued by Campus Safety: chrome-extension://efaidnbmnnnibpcajpcgclefindmkaj/https://www.oit.edu/sites/default/files/2024-4/documents/2024-25%20Klamath%20Falls%20Vehicle%20Regulations%20%26%20Parking%20Information.pdf

2. **QUESTION:** How many back-office users would need to access the Parking Management System simultaneously? This would be for customer service representatives, report running, processing ticket/permit payments, processing ticket appeals, etc.)?

ANSWER: Six (6).

3. **QUESTION:** How many enforcement apps and printer ensembles would be needed? This is usually the maximum number of enforcement officers on shift at the same time.

ANSWER: Three (3).

4. **QUESTION:** Does the university plan to be merchant of record? Or is the vendor expected to be the merchant of record?

ANSWER: Oregon Tech prefers that the vendor to be the merchant of record.

5. **QUESTION:** Do you need fully integrated credit card readers for over-the-counter transactions?

ANSWER: With the assumption that the vendor acts as the merchant of record (see Question 4 and Answer above), the university's Cashier's Office would no longer take payments for parking, and in such circumstances, the university would not need fully integrate credit card readers for over-the-counter transactions.

6. **QUESTION:** How many vehicles would you want to outfit with License Plate Recognition?

ANSWER: One (1), as an option.

7. **QUESTION:** Regarding 2.3 Appeals - Hidden Identifying Information: System must hide identifying information from jurors during appeals. What type of identifying information should be restricted?

ANSWER: Personally identifiable information of permit holders should be restricted. Jurors assigned to an appeal should also remain anonymous.

8. **QUESTION:** Regarding 2.3 Appeals - Juror Verdict Management: Jurors must have specified access to verdict menus with automated response to appellants.

Could Oregon please provide more information around this requirement? Is the expectation that only one of the jurors is applying the results towards the appeal or is the expectation is that all the members of the jurors group going to apply the results? If this is the case, then how many jurors are involved and what happens if each juror had a different response for the single appeal record?

ANSWER: Three (3) jurors are assigned from the members of our traffic commission with their unanimous decision as the final verdict.

9. **QUESTION:** Can you provide some details about the number of permits sold in fiscal year 2022 and 2023?

ANSWER: Please see attached document “Response to Clarifying Questions I – Permits 2022, 2023, 2024,” attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit A**.

10. **QUESTION:** Could you share a breakdown of the permit types and associated costs (E.g. Student, Faculty, Semester, Annual, etc.)

ANSWER: Please reference **Exhibit A**.

11. **QUESTION:** Are there any free permits or special event permits in your permit program, considered in the scope of this RFP? If so, what type, how many?

ANSWER: There are no free permits or special event permits at this time, but Oregon Tech would be interested in implementing this in the future.

12. **QUESTION:** What was last year and/or 2022 Parking Revenue, broken down by source type if possible?

13. **QUESTION:** How many tickets are issued annually at the campus? Could you share a breakdown of the citations issued?
